Dear Friends of The FISH,

Quite often, the staff and volunteers at the FISH Food Pantry receive questions about what is our relationship with UCAN. We explain that we are not part of UCAN, but are a partner in reducing hunger in Douglas County. So that raises the question: Did you know that the FISH of Roseburg is a stand-alone, independent, non-profit organization?

It's true! While UCAN, or United Community Action Network, was founded in 1969, the FISH of Roseburg came into being in 1971. Six local churches came together and formed the FISH Food Pantry in order to provide low-income families with an emergency food source. Through the years, these churches maintained a steadfast determination to continue feeding families and individuals in need. They did so through storing food in broom closets, cupboards, and anywhere else they could think of within their individual churches. And as the mission grew, so did the need, and it was through this need that led the FISH Pantry to be housed within UCAN's building on Harvard Avenue years ago.

Over time and through many transitions, the FISH Food Pantry ultimately ended up in its own building in 2008 where it is now, just down the hill from UCAN. And while we provide food directly into the hands of those in need, UCAN stores and distributes food from a variety of sources for the county's network of kitchens and food pantries. In other words, we have created a partnership with one another in order to provide emergency food to low-income Douglas County residents. When the Oregon Food Bank distributes food to Douglas County, it is sent to one location, which is to the UCAN warehouse. Two days per week, volunteer drivers from the FISH Pantry transport food from UCAN to the FISH Pantry, where we are then able to store it in our warehouse and hand it out to our clients. UCAN, as the regional food bank, is the only distribution center in Douglas County of Federal (USDA) foods. The FISH of Roseburg is the largest food pantry in Douglas County that provides food to families and persons in need. While a large amount of the food we distributes comes from UCAN, we still need to purchase food and receive direct food donations each month to meet the requests for assistance from our clients.

Although UCAN and the FISH of Roseburg are indeed separate, non-profit agencies, with separate boards of directors, we have an outstanding partnership and working relationship. We work together every day to ensure that no person in Douglas County should ever have to go hungry. Our residents can count on that. And p.s., the original founding churches mentioned earlier? Well, they too still continue to work tirelessly every day to support The FISH, because they still believe in the mission that our friends and neighbors are too important to go without food.
